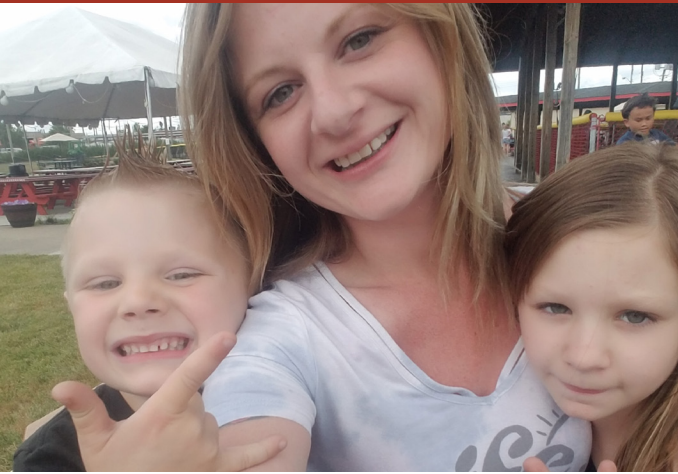

2021 was a year that made tough times even harder for families who were already wondering how to make ends meet. Christmas was a dread rather than something to look forward to and celebrate.

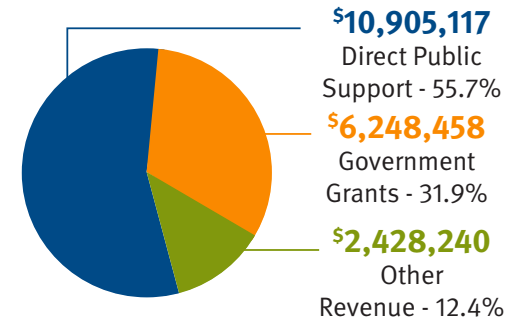
You saw a need and made sure single moms like Stephanie were able to give their children a Christmas to remember.

So many students face so much at home that the last thing on their mind is having school supplies. But this year was entirely different. They needed your support more than ever.

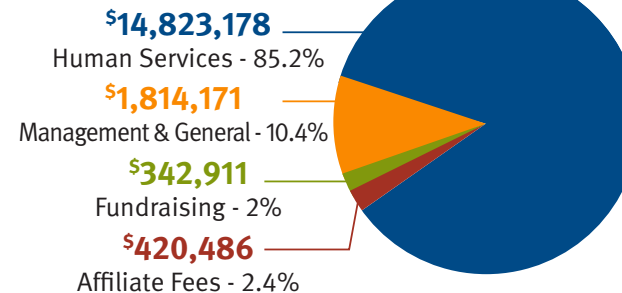
In the midst of a global pandemic, you showed up. You made sure students across Michigan had the tools they needed to succeed in these unprecedented times.
